


5. If the Court is surrounded by a high white linen cloth fence, by which way only can we come into the Court?





In the Gospel Age, as we draw close to God, we come into the Court. In the Kingdom, the world will come close to God in the Court.











Living in the Holy. . .


Those who have given their whole heart to God live with their minds eating the Bread of Life and letting their light shine.
